For wide-ruled paper, write 2 or more single-spaced pages in your journal.</li><li>• If you consult sources before you write, be sure to document the sources so that you have that information for your Works Cited page. This citation information is not included in your page-count for your journal writing; that is, you must still write one or two pages of content.</li><li>• It can be helpful to set a timer for 10 or 15 minutes and force yourself to write without stopping until the timer goes off.</li></ul>
